UNI Compliance Council

Purpose: The primary purpose of the UNI Compliance Council is to ensure that the University of Northern Iowa maintains institutional control of its athletics program. The Council will be responsible for the implementation and implication of NCAA legislation, institutional and athletic conference rules; procedural enhancements; coordination and communication of information among Council members, coaches, and university administrators; and relevant areas of concern regarding student athletes.

Membership:

Compliance Council members will include: NCAA Faculty Representative; Senior Assistant Director of Admissions; Assistant Director of Financial Aid and Gift Aid; Scholarship Specialist-Financial Aid; Athletics Department Director for Compliance; Senior Associate Athletic Director and Senior Woman Administrator; Assistant Registrar; Athletic Academics Advisers and Graduate Assistant in the Compliance office.

The NCAA Faculty Representative shall act as Compliance Council chair. The chair will be responsible for arranging monthly meetings, establishing the agenda, taking meeting notes and providing Council members with a copy of each meeting's notes within one week after each meeting. The FAR will present to the IAAC each month a brief summary of the Council meeting immediate prior to the IAAC meeting. A summary of the Council's yearly activities will be included in the annual report filed by the FAR to the University President.

Meetings: One 1.5 hr meeting per month September through April. One all-day retreat in June. Other meetings to be scheduled as needed.

Meetings will be on the third Wednesday morning of each month. Current meeting time: 9-10:30 am

Meeting Location: Conference Room in Athletics Department Offices

Meeting Format:

First 10-15 minutes: discuss particular [ad hoc] issues/concerns from members.

45-60 minutes: review and evaluation of reports generated by each institutional office; review and evaluation of current university compliance procedures; implementation & implication of NCAA legislation; review of key compliance issues; review of the student –athlete exit interview report; and any additional issues, policies, needs that should arise.

Recommendations. Any recommendations made by the Compliance Council at their monthly meetings and/or during the June retreat will be presented to the IAAC for discussion and approval.
