

September 19, 2015 Memo to UNI Faculty Senate

Dear Senators,

I am attaching the document (s) that provide a description of the Bachelor of Applied Science degree and the two majors being proposed for this degree (Criminal Justice and Tactical Emergency Services with Vulnerable Populations) as was requested at the Faculty Senate meeting held on September 14, 2015.

The degree description as well as the specific majors that have come forward in this curriculum cycle were developed at the department level (majors) while the Liberal Arts Core (LAC) requirements were discussed with each of the College Senates and the Liberal Arts Core Committee (LACC). After these discussions, the LACC developed the current model for the proposal put forth. Both the degree and LAC requirements have been approved through appropriate faculty groups (College Senates and/or LACC and the UCC) prior to coming to the Faculty Senate.

The language in the attached degree description is based on language coming from the majors and the LACC conversations and the language put forth through the curriculum cycle to the UCC committee.
