M. Conrad shared credits are being added to the elective requirements for accreditation purposes.

• PERF-MM: Major in Performance (edited)

S. Coon shared the minimum hours for Wind, Percussion, Keyboard or String specialization adds up to 19-credit hours. She asked if the program's total hours should be changed to 31-36 credit hours. S. Coon said there is no specialization emphasis left that has a minimum of 20 hours. M. Conrad shared this error has probably been in the catalog and just wasn't caught. S. Hendrix-Case stated when advising, the ensemble and music electives are coded together. Due to the range in credit hours with the electives and the ensemble, students end up with a minimum of 21 hours for the specialization. S. Hendrix-Case said the Wind, Percussion, Keyboard or Strings minimum hours should be 21 - 23. The total hours for the major are 33-36. R. Kidwell will make that edit.
