Summary of Changes for CBA UNDERGRADUATE-Level Curriculum Proposals – 2017-18 Curriculum

On August 31, 2016, the University Curriculum Committee (UCC) reviewed the College of Business Administration's Curriculum Packet except for previously approved curriculum proposal for the BAS: Managing Business and Organizations and the 10 associated classes with this program. The packet was approved (pending any changes noted in 8-31-16 UCC minutes) by the UCC on 8-31-16 for all except the Economics BA, which was approved on 9-7-16 (noted in 9-7-16 UCC minutes).

 - The purpose of the minor is to provide an introduction to the concepts of entrepreneurship; will build on the current certificate but adds a major specific course and an additional Marketing course.
 - With the addition of courses, the minor will expand on the certificate by allowing students to learn entrepreneurship skills that specifically fit their major and career.
