

Summary of CSBS Graduate-Level Curriculum Proposals – 2017-2018 Curriculum

On September 13, 2016 the Graduate College Curriculum Committee (GCCC) reviewed the College of Social and Behavioral Science's Graduate Curriculum Packet.

The entire packet was approved (pending any changes noted in GCCC minutes) by the Graduate College.

Summary of Changes for CSBS

A. Department of Psychology: change to MA program; 1 course dropped, 2 added and 2 edits to existing courses

- › PSYCH-MA *Major in Psychology* (edited program) - adjusted to reflect dropped/added courses
- › PSYCH 6408 *External Clinical Practicum* dropped and replaced by PSYCH 6416 *External Clinical Practicum I* (new course) and PSYCH 6417 *External Clinical Practicum II* (new course). No change in credit hours
- › PSYCH 3004/5004 *History and Systems of Psychology* (terms offered change)
- › PSYCH 4705/5705 *Research Experience in Psychology* (description change)

B. Department of Social Work: 3 edits to existing classes, one new course
