

Summary of CSBS UNDERGRADUATE-Level Curriculum Proposals - 2016 Curriculum

On September 9, 16, 23 the University Curriculum Committee (UCC) reviewed the College of Social and Behavioral Sciences Curriculum Packet except for the previously approved new programs and their associated courses - BAS: Criminal Justice and BAS: Tactical Emergency Services with Vulnerable Populations

The entire packet was approved (pending any changes noted in UCC minutes) by the UCC.

Summary of Changes for CSBS

1) Military Sciences

- a. Added one course MIL SCI 1090
- b. Made editorial changes to 8 courses: MIL SCI 1091, 1092, 1093, 1094, 3116, 3117, 3118, 3119; these changes put curriculum titles in line with Army Doctrine

2) Psychology

- a. Automatic drops of 2 seldom/never offered courses (PSYCH 2703, 3605)
- b. Editorial changes made to 3 courses including number change, name change and description change (PSYCH 2002, 3179, 3502)

3) School of Health Sciences

a. Textiles and Apparel

- 1) Automatic drop of 1 seldom/never offered course (TXTDSGN 1017)
- 2) Editorial change in term offering for 1 course (TXTDSGN 3009)

b. TAPP Minor

- 1) Reflects automatic drop of TXTDSGN 1017

c. Interior Design

- 1) **BA: Interior Design** – Program is going through accreditation and after feedback from industry consultants and alumni, changes incorporated into this major reflect feedback to match curriculum with industry standards.
 - a) Modified major will be 65 hours (from 64 hours)
- 2) Edits were made to 12 courses INTDSGN: 1001, 1063, 1065, 1067, 2063, 2067, 2069, 3063, 3152, 4152, 4162 and 4184; included a variety of changes in: title, number, description, credit hours, term offered
- 3) 5 courses were added as new courses either as a result of redistributing existing course credit or due to consultant's recommendation.

d. BA: Gerontology

- 1) Automatic drops of 2 courses seldom or never offered – SOC 3065, SW 3712

- e. **Gerontology minor**
 - 1) Automatic drop of seldom or never offered course SOC 3065
 - f. **BA: Family Services**
 - 1) Reflects automatic drop of 1 seldom/never offered course SW 4142
- 4) **Sociology/Anthropology/Criminology**
- a. **Anthropology**
 - 1) **BA: Anthropology** – Have reorganized their major into 5 categories and outline electives more clearly; have added 2 courses: ANTH 4485 – Internship requirement based on APR; ANTH 4016 (previously approved)
 - 2) 1 edited course ANTH 2420 which is a number change
 - 3) Dropping 3 courses due to being seldom/never offered (ANTH 3301, 3410/5410, 3430)
 - b. **Criminology**
 - 1) **BA: Criminology** – Will be adding a Criminal Justice emphasis (Group 4); adding 4 courses as possible course electives for this Applied Criminal Justice emphasis (CRIM 2500, 2502, 2504, 2506)
 - 2) Deleting 2 courses that are no longer needed: CRIM 3110, 4262/5262; added 1 course - CRIM 4371; change in description for 1 course (CRIM 4381/5381)
 - c. **Sociology**
 - 1) **BA: Sociology** – Have added a new required course (SOC 2000) to major; dropped 2 electives due to automatic drop (SOC 3065/5065, 4200) and added 2 previously existing courses into this group (SOC 3070/5070, SOC/CAP 3151); total hours unchanged
 - 2) Adding 3 new courses (SOC 2000, 3175 and 4035/5035) with editorial changes being made in 3 courses (SOC 3070/5070, 4015.5015, ad 4025/5025) in title and description
 - d. **Certificate in Sociology of Family and Life Course**
 - 1) Reflects the automatic dropped course of SOC 3065/5065, an elective in the Sociology options; total hours unchanged
 - e. **Certificate in Sociology of Race/Ethnicity and Immigration**
 - 1) Reflects the automatic dropped course of SOC 3065/5065, an elective in the Sociology options; total hours unchanged
- 5) **Geography**
- a. Dropping 3 courses as seldom/never offered: GEOG 4130/5130, 4140/5140, 4520/5520

6) Political Science

- a. 3 courses listed were previously approved in last cycle (POL AMER 3172/5172, 4153/5153, 4173/5173) with revised MPP program
- b. 2 courses were automatically dropped due to seldom/never offered (POL GEN 3188, POL THRY 3122)

7) History

- a. **BA: History** - redistribution of history electives to more evenly distribute courses between 3 options in major; clarifies required Humanities courses for History majors; total hours for major remains unchanged
- b. **BA: History Teaching** – reflects the automatic drop of HISNW 4710/5710; total hours for majors remains unchanged
- c. **Certificate in Public History**
 - 1) Editorial change that states that a combination of courses can be taken for 6 credit hours for the certificate; total hours unchanged
- d. **Minor in Public History** – new program proposal
 - 1) 18 hour minor – Similar to certificate in Public History but students take a few additional hours for minor (15 hrs)
- e. Automatic drops of 2 seldom/never offered classes (HISNW 4710/5710, HISUS 4280/5280); edits to titles and/or descriptions of 7 classes (HISNW 4720/5720, HIST 1010, 1011, 4010/5010, 4030/5030, HISUS 4220/5250, 4270/5270; 1 new class HISUS 4190/5190 which been taught several times as experimental course.

8) Social Work

- a. **BA: Social Work** - added and eliminated courses in the concentration areas. Total hours for major are unchanged.
- b. 9 courses being edited with 8 of these dropping the 5000 level graduate designation (SW 4121,4143, 4144, 4163,4164, 4193, 4195, 4196) and 1 course undergoing number change (SW 1001); Automatic drop of 2 seldom/never offered classes
- c. **Conflict Resolution Certificate** – reflects the automatic drop of GEOG 4140/5140 as an elective; total hours remain unchanged
- d. **Social Welfare Minor** – reflects the automatic drop of SW 4172/5172 and the editorial number change of SW 2042 to SW 1001; total hours remain unchanged

9) Social Science Teaching

- a. **Plan A – Specialist**
 - 1) There are 4 course additions (HIST 1010, HISNW 4730/5730, 4870/5870, 4880/5890) and 4 deletions (HISNW 4710/5710, SOC 3065/5065, GEOG 4130/5130, 4520/5520 in Plan A in the elective options; total hours remain unchanged

b. Plan B – All Social Science

- 1) There are 4 course additions (HIST 1010, HISNW 4730/5730, 4870/5870, 4880/5890) and 6 deletions (HISUS 4280/5280, HISNW 4710/5710, GEOG 4130/5130, 4140/5140, 4520/5520, SOC 3065 in Plan B in the elective options; total hours remain unchanged.
